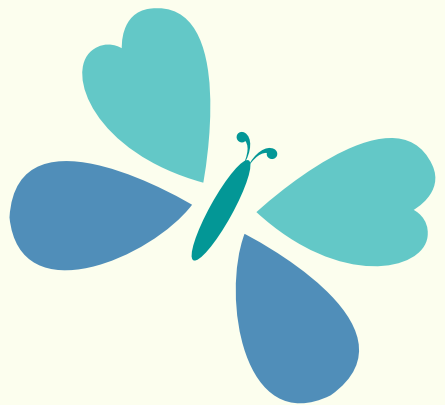

-Water and maybe some snacks

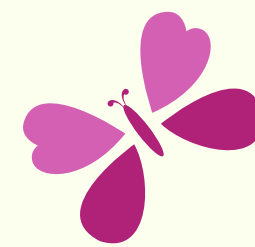
The walk should take approximately about an hour.
