




Key Vocabulary


Skeleton (Science)	The framework of bones that supports our bodies.
Human (Science)	Having the characteristics of people.
Senses (Science)	Any of five ways to experience our surroundings.
Organs (Science)	A group of things inside the body that help it to work, e.g. heart and lungs.
Seasons (Science)	Four different times of the year with different types of weather.
Countries (Geography)	A land lived in by people of the same government.
Capital city (Geography)	The area where the government of that country works.
Village (Geography)	Settlements of people clustered around a central point, larger than a hamlet but smaller than a town.
Address (Geography)	The place where you live, or a school is located. The address has the street name and number, village or town, city and county.
Hundertwasser (Art)	Austrian artist and architect with a passion for spirals and bold colours. His best known work is the Hundertwasser haus in Vienna, Austria.

Seasonal Change

A **season** is a division of the year marked by **changes** in weather, ecology, and the amount of daylight. On Earth, **seasons** are the result of Earth's orbit around the Sun and Earth's axial tilt relative to the ecliptic plane.


