Pupil Premium

The Government continues to provide schools with additional funding to support the learning of pupils where at least one parent is in receipt of particular benefits (see over for details). This is called Pupil Premium.

This procedure for eligibility will be carried out termly by Wokingham Borough Council, to confirm that you are still eligible. However, if your personal circumstances change during this time **you must inform us.**

This money is to support your child's development. In school, we can use the money to provide additional learning support, to ensure your child makes good progress through the Infant School.

We can also offer to cover costs for educational activities, including school visits/visitors, after and before school activity clubs or support with the purchase of uniform, free milk, PTA Disco and Movie nights, all of which support and enhance your child's learning.

If you receive any of the benefits listed the council may be able to claim additional funding to support your child's education. Please complete the information below, which will enable us to make an automatic and confidential check to confirm that you are eligible.

PUPIL PREMIUM
FREE SCHOOL MEALS (FOR CHILDREN IN YEAR 5 OR ABOVE)

To be eligible, at least one parent must be in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal credit
- Income support
- *Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit* and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190
- The Guarantee element of the State Pension Credit

*Note: If you continue to receive Working Tax Credit during the four week period immediately after your employment stops or after you start to work fewer than 16 hours per week, your child would still be eligible for free school meals for this four week period.
