The "Against Year X Expectations" section shows how your child is progressing compared to the national expectations for their year group. The goal is for every child to be working at or above these age-related expectations, or making progress towards them from their starting point.

There's also a section on your child's effort and engagement levels, with a key on the report to help explain these. These comments shouldn't be a surprise, as they will have already been shared with you by your child's teacher.



