**Jesus showed love to people who were ignored or treated unfairly.**

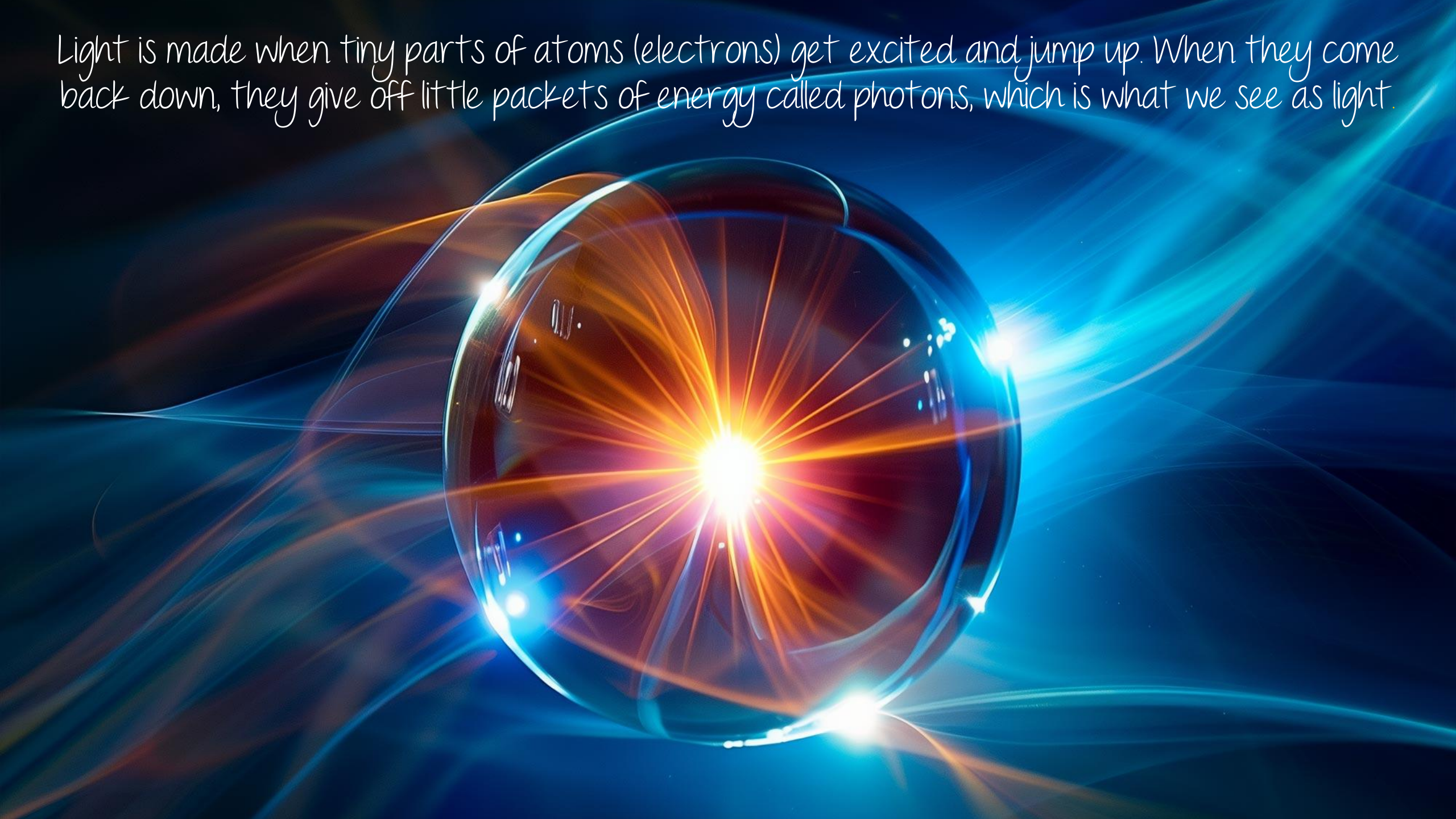
- **Being kind means:**

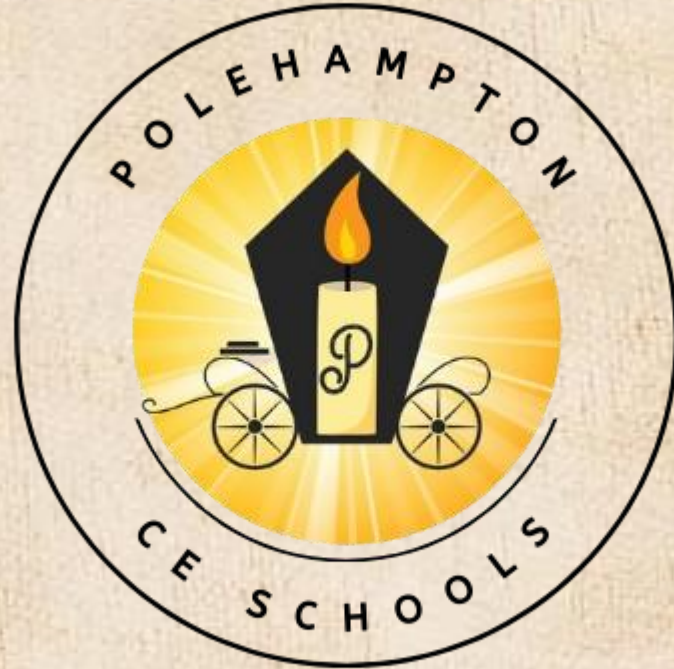
